



NET Health operates the Immunizations Clinic at 815 North Broadway in Tyler.

Necessary immunizations will require that parents remember the following:

- ❖ Children who are on Medicaid and CHIP will need their parents to present their cards at the time of service and there is no charge for the vaccine. Those who do not have any form of insurance will be assessed a \$10.00 administration fee per vaccine at the time of service.

This payment can only be made in the form of a check or cash.

- ❖ We are unable to give the Texas Vaccines For Children (TVFC) vaccines to insured children. In order to get their insurance verified, parents need to contact our office **BEFORE** the vaccination.

To receive TVFC immunizations, you must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- a.) Is an American Indian, or
- b.) Is an Alaskan Native, or
- c.) Is a patient who receives benefits from Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP), or
- d.) Is enrolled in Medicaid, or
- e.) Does not have health insurance (Uninsured), or
- f.) Is underinsured, which can be determined if the child:
 - a. has commercial (private) health insurance, but coverage does not include vaccines
 - b. insurance covers only selected vaccines (TVFC-eligible for non-covered vaccines only)

- ❖ The private health insurances that we can file on is Blue Cross Blue Shield, Cigna, & United Health Care.

We will not verify insurance at the time of service.

Children covered by any other private insurance company can receive vaccines at these prices:

TDap = \$50.00 MCV4 = \$120.00 Varicella = \$140.00 MMR = \$100.00 Hepatitis B = \$80.00
