Basic Food Worker Certification & Registration Requirements

Effective January 1, 2016

Per recent State of Texas legislation, local health jurisdictions are no longer allowed to collect transfer or registration fees for Food Handler Training certificates issued by ANSI Accredited food handler training courses. S.B. 582

The Northeast Texas Public Health District (NET Health) will now only maintain a registry for basic food worker certificates of students taught by NET Health. Each employer is responsible for maintaining valid food worker certificates for all conditional employees and employees hired to work in a food establishment. The employee name, certificate and hire date must be available for review upon request by the inspector.

A valid food worker certificate is not expired and is at least one of the following:

1. ANSI (American National Standards Institute) Approved
2. TX DSHS License (Texas Department of State Health Services) Approved

BASIC FOOD WORKER CLASS OPTIONS

TRADITIONAL CLASSROOM TRAINING: The NET Health Environmental Health Department teaches a TX DSHS approved basic food handler training. This training is recognized by the State of Texas and can be used in other jurisdictions. This 2 hour basic food worker course is offered in English & Spanish the 2nd Monday of each month.

REGISTRATION: Pre-registration is strongly encouraged.

PAYMENT: Pre-payment is required if pre-registering. The cost is \$15 per person. Payment is non-refundable.

ON-SITE CLASS OPTIONS: On-site English classes are available Monday through Friday. Each location will need to be evaluated for feasibility and approval. There is a minimum of 20 students per class. Please contact the Environmental Health Department if you are interested in scheduling an on-site class. We ask that you give us a two week advance notice. Once a date and location have been confirmed, please submit a printed/typed roster and payment one week prior to the class. Payment is non-refundable and non-transferable. The cost for us to bring class to you is \$20.00 per Student.

ON-LINE FOOD HANDLER CLASS: Food handler courses are also available on-line in several languages.
